

New technology park proposed

Plans are to be submitted for a new £100 million technology park at Great Blakenham on the outskirts of Ipswich which the developer claims will bring 700-1000 well paid jobs to the area.

Braceforce, which has developed the adjacent Orion Business Park, says it has received interest from over 50 companies across the EU interested in locating at the site, to



be called the St James' Technology Park. To provide access to the site, the developer is planning a £1m gyratory system with a dual carriageway link to the A14. The plan includes the development of over 300,000sq ft of high-tech space over a three-year period with a further 200,000 sq ft of logistical support warehousing.
